Sub: Protection and preservation of the Hooghly Imambarah Wakf Estate, Hooghly E.C.No.4649.

Sir.

Late Haji Md. Mohsin, a pious and religious minded man dedicated his valuable properties for religious and charitable purposes as well as for the benefit of the poor and meritorious muslim students. All these properties were enrolled in this office as "Hooghly Imambara Wakf Estate" being E.C.No.4649 comprising of several properties at Hooghly and Kolkata. Hooghly Imambara is one of the Wakf properties. It was built by late Haji Md. Mohein and has got historical importance. For the last several years this Imambara is being treated us heritage building and almost throughout the year tourists from all over the country visit the place. After the death of the Wakif i.e. Haji Md. Mohsin there was a dispute between the relatives of Wakif and a group of devotees from Shia community for taking the management of the Imambara as well as for other properties in Hooghly and Kolkata. The claimants fought each other in court and the Hon'ble Court pending this dispute appointed one Mr. Sardar Amjad Ali, Advocate, Calcutta High Court as the Receiver of the said "Wakf Estate". Surder Amjud Ali acted as a Receiver since and during these period he never submitted any account of the cutate nor he deposited any Waki Contribution. He also did not take any care for the maintenance of the Imambara and as a result the entire building is in a very dilapidated condition. For negligence its prime properties have gone under the illegal encroachers. The tenants in Houghly & Kulkata are not paying any rent. Seeing this deplurable condition one Sayed Jamrud Husan being a well wisher moved the matter before the Hon'tle High Court and the Hon'ble Court passed an order dated 08-03-2002 directing the Board of Wakis, West Bengal to constitute a committee of management consisting of 5 (five) persons from and amongst the Shia community to manage the Wakl Estate. In pursuance of this order the Board of Walefa, West Bengal in its meeting held on 19-08-2002 constituted a committee of management after observing all formalities. The names are given below :-

Taking the advantage of this situation the tenants are not paying any heed to the committee. No income is derived from the properties due to these reluctant tenants and illegal encroachers. The said Imambara requires immediate repair. Many valuable articles lying inside the Imambara are going to be ruined. All the properties under Hooghly Imambara are under Touzi No.92 and the properties in Kolkata are in Kidderpore area (list is enclosed).

In view of the facts and circumstances above I am directed by the Hon'ble Chairman of the Board to request you to kindly look into the matter and extend your kind co-operation and administrative help so that this committee of management can function properly. It is needless to mention that without these help the committee cannot proceed further in the matter. It is our utmost duty to take proper care of this Wakf Estate and to maintain and protect this historical place.

An early action in the matter is solicited.
